News Bulletin

At the Annual General Meeting (AGM) a motion was passed to defer the decision to the Board regarding the use of points for Muree Golf Club membership renewal. At the AGM, members that wished to provide input to the Board on this matter were requested to write to the Board outlining their thoughts. Two submissions were received and a petition signed by members was also received.

The Board discussed the matter at the last monthly meeting, taking into account the information received from members and I advise of the following outcome:

- Golfing Members may use points accumulated over the previous 12 months to subsidise up to 50 percent of their annual golfing fees.
- Golfing members may also use points accumulated over the previous 12 months to subsidise up to 50 percent of the cost of cart storage at Muree Golf Club.
- This is to be reviewed again by the Board for the year 2018/2019, so is not to be considered a perpetual resolution.

Further, the General Manager will, in the very near future, post a notice on the notice boards around the Club, identifying exactly what can and cannot be purchased by points within the Club. This will be done to quell the erroneous rumours circulating the Club about what may, or may not be purchased by accumulated points.

It must be noted though, that gaming monies (poker machine) held on member's accounts, by law, must be cashed out at the bar in order to purchase anything within the Club.
